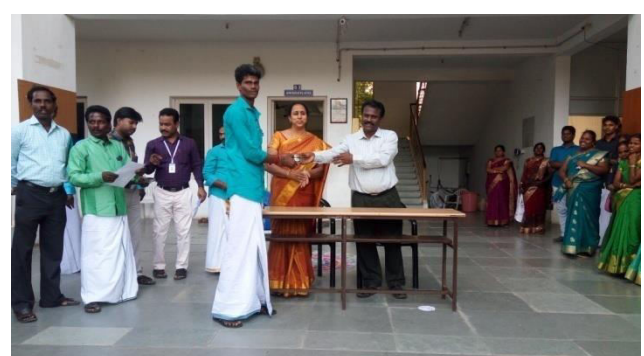




### **Pongal Celebration**

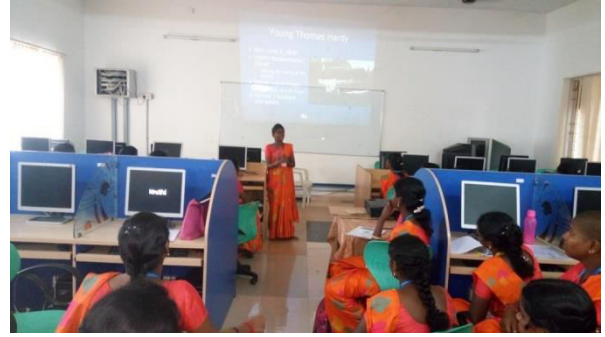
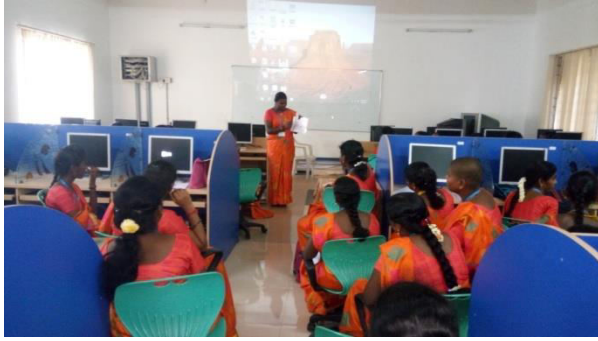






## TECHNOLOGY IN HAND PREPARATI

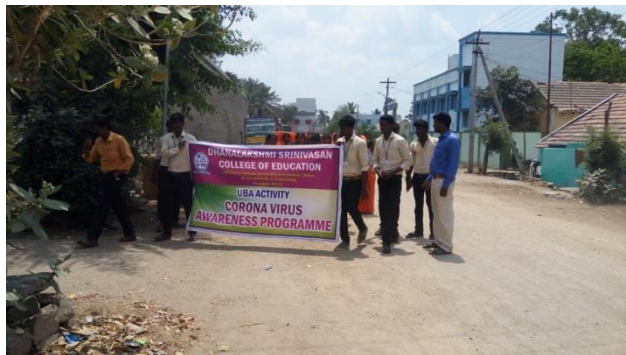


## **CORONA VIRUS AWARENESS RALLY**
